KNOX JUNIOR RAIDERS UNIFORM POLICY

This policy is effective Inside any venue where any Knox Junior Raiders Team(s) is(are) Playing, &/or Training.

To provide players and parents with the expected Knox Junior Raiders standards of dress and appearance for games and training.

PLAYING UNIFORM – Once a player arrives at a venue they are representing Knox Raiders and must be suitably attired.

All players are to come to games dressed in Navy and Yellow Raiders apparel.

Suitable Attire = Knox Raiders Warm-Up Top, Navy Blue KJR tracksuit top, or other Approved apparel.

The team warm up must be conducted in any of the above or alternatively the playing uniform. NO other combinations other than those approved are acceptable.

It is important to note the rules and regulations regarding uniforms and the player's obligations once they are identifiable as a member of Knox Junior Raiders.

<u>Grey Knox Raider Apparel is supporter wear only and should not be worn to or from games by the Players.</u>

TRAINING UNIFORM – Please ensure that players wear appropriate training attire, to all training sessions. This consists of:

- 1) Knox Raiders training shorts.
- 2) Knox Raiders reversible singlet only These are not to be branded in any way other than Knox Raiders.

Unacceptable branded clothing includes, but not limited to:

U14 National Championships, NITP, State Teams/Training Squad, Tournament related products and ANY Apparel of another Association.

Knox Junior Raiders will supply a playing singlet for each player which is to be worn to games ONLY. Players must ensure that this top is cared for in an appropriate manner. These singlets must be returned at the end of the season.

A change uniform is also provided. This is retained and maintained by Team Managers. These will be given out at games, as required, then collected at the end of the game. Change Uniform is not to be taken home by players.

Any singlet that is lost, or returned in an unacceptable condition, above normal wear and tear, will be charged \$50 per singlet. Note: Players are required to provide their own shorts, socks and footwear.

Playing shorts and singlets are NOT to be worn during training sessions, this is to preserve the best possible appearance for game time.

It is expected that players will have the required full uniform (training and playing) by the commencement of the Championship season. It is important to understand that Players wearing non-approved apparel could be subject to disciplinary action and review.

TEAM MANAGERS:

As the Team Manager, it is important you remember that you are also representing Knox Raiders. We request that you wear Knox Raiders apparel if possible, this helps portray the best image to the players that you too are in support.

Polo Tops are available from the Sports Store and help to identify you as part of the team.

TOURNAMENT SOUVENIER UNIFORMS & APPAREL

Most Tournament hosts will have clothing for sale.

In accordance with the policies above, these are not permitted to be worn at Knox Junior Raider games, or training.

Knox Raiders Designed Team Tournament Apparel.

Occasionally Knox Junior Raiders teams may wish to purchase Team Tournament Uniform.

This is popular when playing in Interstate Tournaments (eg Norwood Classic @ Easter).

There are rules in place regarding the uniform that is purchased for this purpose:

- 1) Design of apparel is controlled and at the discretion of Knox Basketball CEO.
- 2) Player Names may be added to these uniforms, but will be limited to Player Surname. This portrays an image of consistency & unity across all Teams, within the Knox Association.
- 3) Apparel is to be sourced from KBI Approved Vendor ONLY

Teams may wish to source sponsorship to assist with the costs related to a team's Tournament participation. Allocated space for sponsor logo is allowed for in the design and is limited to this format.

4) ALL sponsors must be Approved by KBI Management prior to receiving any payments. This is to ensure that conflict with Association Sponsors is avoided.

Teams are to submit sponsor requests to KJR Committee for discussion with KBI Management.

Note: The purchase of such uniform is NOT mandatory.

This uniform is also inappropriate for Game Day and Training.

On return from the Tournament, this attire is subject to standard policies above.

Please ensure that ALL personally owned Knox Raiders Apparel is labeled with Player name. Stadium Staff and Knox Junior Raider Committee will do their best to ensure that it is returned to the family. Unmarked clothing is placed in consolidated lost clothing bins, at the venue of finding.

NOTE:

It is up to the Coach and the Team Manager to <u>enforce</u> Uniform Rules with the players.
